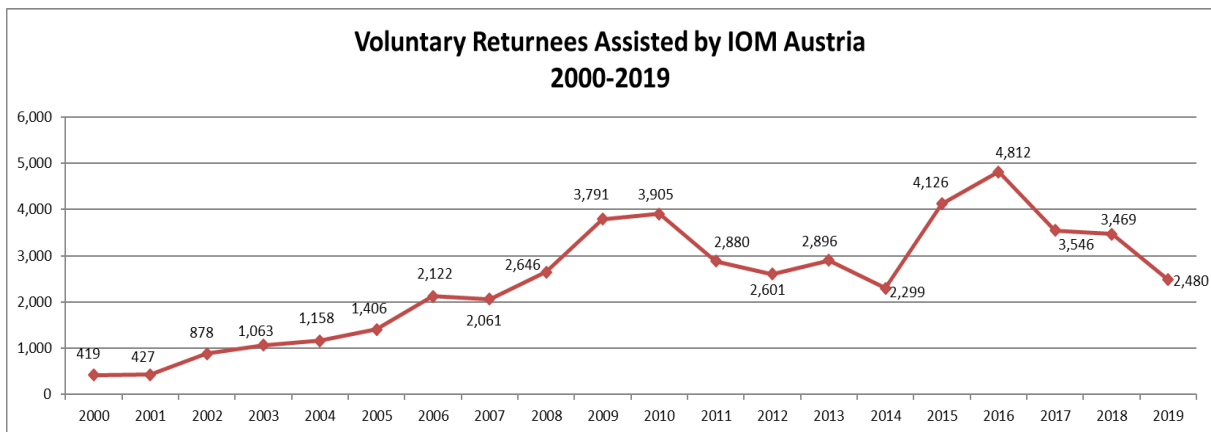


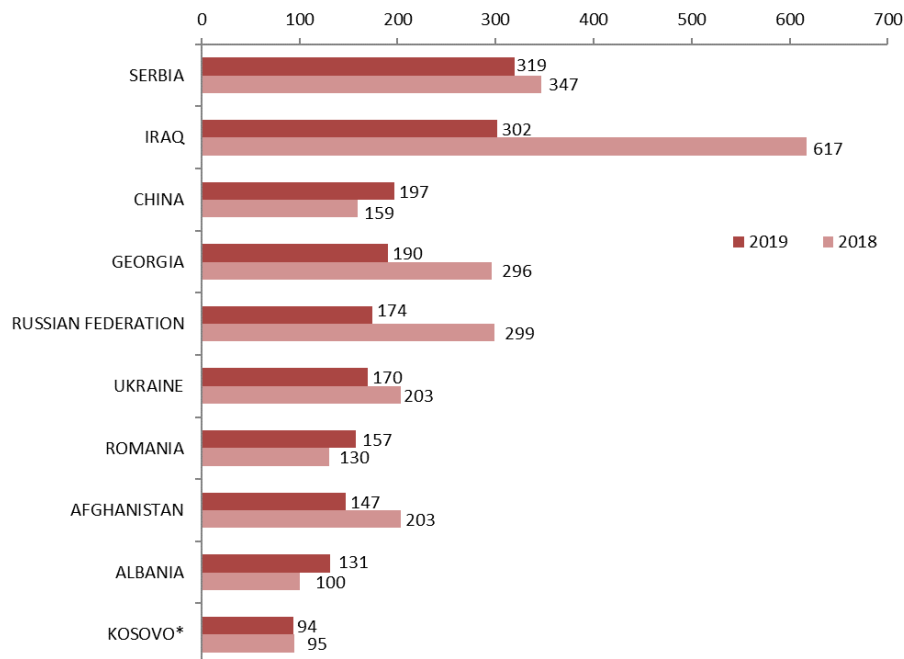
ASSISTED VOLUNTARY RETURN AND REINTEGRATION FROM AUSTRIA

Statistical Overview 2019

IOM Austria provides support for the return of voluntary returnees within the framework of the „General Humanitarian Return Programme”. The travel costs for the majority of returnees, who are assisted by the programme, are covered by the Austrian Federal Office for Immigration and Asylum on the basis of a Memorandum of Understanding that was signed between IOM Austria and the Austrian Ministry of the Interior in 2000.

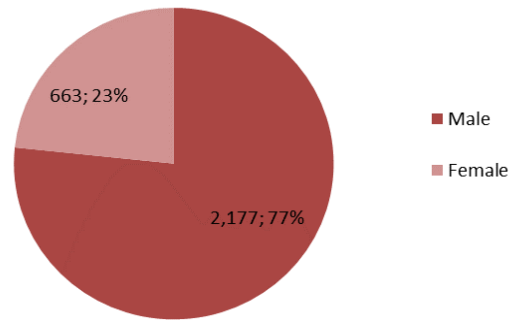


Top 10 Countries of Return 2019

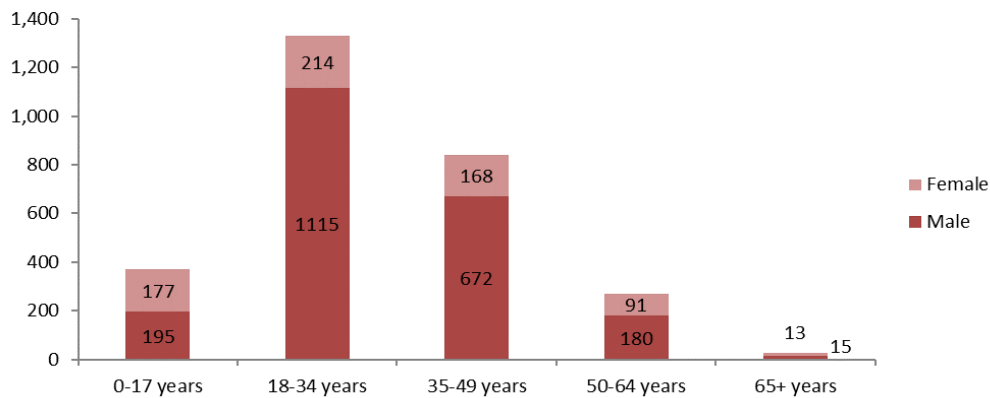


*References to Kosovo shall be understood to be in the context of United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999)

IOM Austria also offered reintegration assistance for voluntary returnees in the framework of the project “RESTART II – Reintegration Assistance for Voluntary Returnees to Afghanistan and Iran”. This project was implemented from 01.01.2017 to 31.12.2019 and co-funded by the Austrian Ministry of the Interior and the European Commission. In addition, voluntary returnees to Afghanistan were supported within a national funded project from October to December 2019.
